NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed bids for the **BEATTY AIRPORT RUNWAY 16-34 OVERLAY** will be received by the **Nye County Purchasing Dept.** at **101 Radar Road**, **Tonopah**, **NV 89049** until **11:00 a.m.**, **local time**, **Wednesday**, **June 13**, **2012**, and then said bids will be publicly opened at **11:15 a.m.** and read aloud.

The proposed work includes the construction of a runway overlay of approximately 39,942 square yards. The project includes a 0.25-inch cold milling of the existing pavement, crack repair, a 0.75-inch plantmix bituminous leveling course, a 1.5-inch plantmix bituminous pavement overlay, grading the runway shoulders, and pavement striping. Also included is the application of post-emergent herbicide to the pavement cracks and the application of preemergent herbicide to the runway shoulders and other miscellaneous areas.

- 1. The proposed contract is under and subject to Executive Order No. 11246, as amended, of September 4, 1965, and to Equal Employment Opportunity (EEO) and Federal Labor Provisions.
- 2. All labor on projects with a construction cost of \$100,000 or greater shall be paid no less than the minimum wage rates established by the U.S. Secretary of Labor or the State of Nevada, whichever is higher.
- 3. Each bidder must supply all the information required by the Bid Documents and Specifications.
- 4. The EEO requirements, labor provisions and wage rates are included in the Specifications and Bid Documents and are available for inspection at the county clerk's office of Nye County.
- 5. Each bidder must complete, sign and furnish prior to the award, a "Certification of Non-segregated Facilities", a statement entitled, "Bidders Statement on Previous Contracts Subject to EEO Clause", and "Assurance of Minority Business Enterprise" as contained in the Bid Proposal.
- 6. A Contractor having 50 or more employees and his subcontractors having 50 or more employees and who may be awarded a contract of \$50,000 or more will be required to maintain an affirmative action program, the standards for which are contained in the Specifications.
- 7. To be eligible for award, each bidder must comply with the affirmative action requirements which are contained in the Specifications.
- 8. This contract will be funded in part by a grant from the Federal Aviation Administration, therefore the requirements of Title 49 CFR Part 26, Participation by Disadvantaged Business Enterprises in Department of Transportation Programs, applies to this contract. Nye County has not set a DBE participation contract goal for this project, however DBE participation is encouraged.

Nye County reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any informality in such bids.

The successful bidder shall file with Nye County at the time of execution of the Contract, a Performance Bond, in an amount of not less than 100 percent of the Contract price and a Labor and Materials Bond, in an amount of not less than 100 percent of the contract price, with a surety or sureties company(s) authorized and licensed to do business in the State of Nevada in accordance with the laws and statutes of the State of Nevada providing for bonds for public works.

Each Proposal must be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check, or bid bond payable to Nye County in an amount not less than ten percent (10%) of the amount bid.

The above mentioned cash, check or bond shall be given as a guarantee that the bidder will enter into the Contract if awarded to him, and will be declared forfeited if the successful bidder refuses to enter into said contract after being notified to do so by Nye County. All bidders must at the time of the bid have a valid Nevada Contractor's License, and the value of the Contract may not exceed the limit on the license.

After the bids have been opened and declared, no bid shall be withdrawn except with the approval of Nye County and each shall be subject to acceptance by Nye County for a period of one hundred and twenty (120) days after the opening date. There is limited funding available for this project and therefore, no adjustments will be made to the lump sum and/or unit prices due to

escalation of fuel prices regardless of when the contract is awarded or when the work is performed.

The work shall be completed within forty-five (45) calendar days, with liquidated damages of \$1,000.00 per calendar day should the Contractor fail to complete the work within the time allowed.

A <u>mandatory</u> Pre-Bid meeting will be held at 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, June 7, 2012 at the Beatty Airport. Bids received from non-attendees will be considered as non-responsive.

Each bidder shall furnish the Owner satisfactory evidence of his/her competency to perform the proposed work at least 3 days prior to the bid opening. Such evidence of competency, unless otherwise specified, shall consist of statements covering the bidder's past experience on similar work, a list of equipment that would be available for the work, and a list of key personnel that would be available. In addition, each bidder shall furnish the owner satisfactory evidence of his/her financial responsibility. Such evidence of financial responsibility shall consist of a confidential statement or report of the bidder's financial resources and liabilities as of the last calendar year or the Contractor's last fiscal year. Such statements or reports shall be certified by a public accountant. At the time of submitting such financial statements or reports, the bidder shall further certify whether his/her financial responsibility is approximately the same as stated or reported by the public accountant. If the bidder's financial responsibility has changed, the bidder shall qualify the public accountant's statement or report to reflect his/her (bidders) true financial condition at the time such qualified statement or report is submitted to the owner. A bidder may submit evidence that he is pre-qualified with the Nevada Department of Transportation and is on the current "bidder's list" of the Nevada Department of Transportation. Such evidence of prequalification with the Nevada Department of Transportation may be submitted as evidence of financial responsibility in lieu of the certified statements or reports required in the previous paragraph.
