(5 days - No Cost Training)**

Course Description: This course provides local- and state-level emergency responders with a robust understanding of the duties, responsibilities, and capabilities of an effective Safety Officer (SOFR) on an All-Hazards Incident Management Team (AHIMT). These responsibilities fall into two categories: 1) responding to the incident and the safety needs of the incident, and 2) effectively fulfilling the position responsibilities of an SOFR on an AHIMT.

Exercises, simulations, discussions, and a final exam enable participants to process and apply their new knowledge.

Course Objectives: Describe the duties, responsibilities, and capabilities of an effective Safety Officer on an All-Hazards Incident Management Team

Required Prerequisites:

IS 0100, Introduction to the Incident Command System
IS 0200, Incident Command System for Single Resources and Initial Action Incidents;
IS 0700, National Incident Management System, An Introduction;
IS 0800, National Response Framework, An Introduction
ICS 300: Intermediate Incident Command System for Expanding Incidents;
ICS 400: Advanced Incident Command System for Command and General Staff—Complex Incidents.
