

OPENING UP NYE COUNTY GOVERNMENT AGAIN



Phase Two

- 1. Public Meetings:** The county will begin to reopen meetings to the public beginning June 2, 2020. The following protocols will be in effect until further notice:
 - a.** Public gatherings can be no more than 50 people, while continuing to follow social distancing. Board members, staff, members of the public and, members of the press are included in the 50-person limit. The public attendance is on a first-come first-served basis
 - b.** Temperature screenings will be conducted prior to entering the meeting. Staff will authorize entry to the facility once temperature has been verified in order to control attendance count
 - c.** Meeting rooms will be properly marked for social distancing. Chairs/rows will be taped/marked off to achieve the 6-foot distance requirement
 - d.** Reduce seating to one seat at the public comment table
 - e.** Chairperson to instruct the audience at the opening of public comment only one person at a time at the public comment table. Public wishing to comment are to remain seated until the current speaker is finished and has sat down. This will also allow time for staff to disinfect the microphone and public comment seating area
 - f.** Teleconference participation is still available for the vulnerable population, those sheltering in place or members of the public in excess of the gathering limit of 50 people
